Our dynamic teaching Faculty bring a wealth of diverse experience to Trillium, and our active mentoring program helps support new teachers in their work. We offer a health and dental plan, and tuition remission for Faculty children.

The Trillium Waldorf School is located on a 3-acre site in the picturesque city of Guelph, Ontario, situated one hour north-west of Toronto, near Kitchener-Waterloo and Cambridge. Access to a local biodynamic farm, Guelph Lake, and conservation trails allows the school to offer outdoor and farming-based programs. This program ensures that we are truly aligned with Rudolf Steiner's intention to offer an education that is accessible to all in order to bring about social renewal.
